



Originally planted in the 1970's, the Fareham's Vineyard that surrounds the Kilikanoon Winery at the Southern end of the Clare Valley has been producing exceptional fruit for almost 50 years.

Our grapes are grown on Ngadjuri country.

### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Nourished by the replenishing winter rains, the 2021 vintage produced balanced yields of intensely flavoured fruit. Cooler than previous seasons, the mild days and cool nights allowed the fruit to ripen slowly. Under these ideal conditions, the Shiraz thrived with the berries naturally concentrating their flavours even further.

### WINEMAKING

Individual parcels were vinified separately, and remained so until the final wine was assembled. Multiple harvests give us the ability to create a complex and layered wine with both youthful and developed characteristics. Maturation in a selection of seasoned French oak barrels for sixteen months provides a softness and elegance to the silky palate.

### COLOUR

Brick red in colour with a crimson hue.

### NOSE

Dark plum and spiced cherry notes are underpinned by lightly charred french oak

### PALATE

Dense flavours of red and dark fruits, blackberry, sweet plums and peppery spice. The core is concentrated and focused, with a long and savoury finish supported by fine oak tannin.
