PLACE

The Killerman's Run range of wines are masterfully composed blends selected from across the finest vineyards and sub regions in the Clare Valley.

Our grapes are grown on Ngadjuri country.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

With rejuvenating winter rains and an early spring warmth, the vines emerged from their dormancy early in the season. The mild weather conditions continued which allowed the Cabernet fruit to ripen slowly and fully, intensifying in flavour through the season. This allowed the teams to harvest parcels at the optimum time.

WINEMAKING

Our Killerman's Run Cabernet Sauvignon has been crafted through traditional winemaking techniques accumulating with twelve months maturation in new and seasoned French oak hogsheads.

COLOUR

Deep red in colour with deep crimson hues.

NOSE

Vibrant varietal black current and tomato leaf lift from the glass

PALATE

The aromas are mimicked on the palate where they are supported by bright red berries that flow gently across the palate with seamlessly integrated tannins that are finely balanced by the natural acidity. The soft yet mouth coating body will give rise to further complexity if cellared carefully.

Sliders, savoury arancini and hand-cut chips.
