

# Killerman's Run

## 2023 CABERNET SAUVIGNON



Mr. Killerman lived in a humble life in the hills behind Kilikanoon. He foraged through the valley for his meals, finding wild rabbit and many other gourmet treats. Killerman's Run reflects the rich landscape and being at one with the environment by sourcing and blending wines from across the Clare Valley.

### PLACE

The Killerman's Run range of wines are masterfully composed blends selected from across the finest vineyards and sub regions in the Clare Valley.

Our grapes are grown on Ngadjuri country.

### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Regenerating winter rainfall paired with mild conditions formed the basis of an ideal growing season. The mild temperatures saw flowering occurring as usual, but the persistent cooler spring days resulted in a slower ripening. This allowed the vines to undertake veraison and develop rich and intense flavours at a lower sugar concentration, slowly maturing to peak ripeness and exceptional quality.

### WINEMAKING

Our Killerman's Run Cabernet Sauvignon has been crafted through traditional winemaking techniques accumulating with twelve months maturation in new and seasoned French oak hogsheads.

### COLOUR

Deep ruby in colour with vibrant burgundy hues.

### NOSE

Intense red currant, cherry and grenadine flavours layered with cinnamon bark and a touch of choc-mint

### PALATE

The aromas are mimicked on the palate by concentrated flavours of juicy red berries and dark fruit that flow gently and integrate seamlessly with the silky tannins and finely balanced natural acidity. Supple and refined, this wine is delightful now and will give rise to further complexity if cellared carefully.
